This guide is a living document intended to help trans individuals and communities navigate hostile environments under an increasingly authoritarian regime, with a specific focus on surviving the renewed Trump-era conditions. It includes a state-by-state breakdown of anti-trans legislation, legal protections, mutual aid networks, sanctuary cities, underground support structures, and practical strategies for safety, movement, and resistance.
